## **Christ Lutheran Church “Neighbors Helping Neighbors”**



**Purpose:** This service is to give assistance to church members during an extended illness or recuperation; or to those who are at a point in their lives when assistance with meals would be welcomed.

**What is the service?** A freshly prepared meal is delivered cool in a microwave container each day (Monday - Friday; Friday includes meals for Saturday and Sunday). Recipients heat and eat the meal any time they wish. All meals are nutritionally sound, sodium conservative and diabetic friendly. Meals are delivered by church volunteers between 11:00 a.m. and 1:00 p.m.

**Who provides the meals?** Meals are provided by Wildwood Catering at 5429 Peavine Road, Crossville, TN 38571, 931-707-0736. They may be able to supply your meal needs beyond the scope of this special program.

**What does the service cost?** Your meals have been paid for by the contribution of another person. If you are able to “pay it forward,” the cost of the seven (7) meals for the week is \$42.25.

**How can I contribute for the meals?** You may contribute any amount you wish and are able to afford. Write a check to Christ Lutheran Church with a note “Neighbors Helping Neighbors.” Send it to the church at 481 Snead Drive, Crossville, TN 38558 or give it to your volunteer deliverer. Note the amount of your donation for taxable charity can only be the amount that exceeds the cost of the services you have received.

**How can I request the service?** Call the Church Office at 931-484-7273 and give them your name, telephone number, and the Monday you wish to start the service. Please allow five (5) days to allow us to arrange for volunteers to pickup and deliver your meals.

**What if I have special dietary needs?** Special dietary needs can be accommodated, such as a diet for someone who is diabetic, has a wheat intolerance, or needs a chemotherapy “boost” diet. A special dietary need would need to be specified at the beginning.

**How can I cancel the service?** Call the Church Office at 931-484-7273 and give your name, telephone number, and the service will be stopped at the end of the current week.

**Can I skip a meal during the week?** You can skip a meal during the week due to a special occasion, i.e. doctor’s appointment, luncheon, or being out of town. This can be accomplished by calling Wildwood Catering at 931-707-0736 the day before by 3:00 p.m.

**Who are the volunteer deliverers?** They are members at Christ Lutheran Church who have received additional training to best serve your needs through daily visits when delivering the meal.

**Will I always have the same person delivering my meals?** Every effort will be made to have the same person delivering your meals but the personal schedules of the volunteers may require another volunteer to deliver your meal.

**Are there other benefits to the service?** Yes, you have the same person making the delivery most of the time who will check on your safety and changing needs.
